From I-5 Southbound:

Take exit 172 to merge onto N 85th Street
Turn left on Greenwood Avenue North
Greenwood Masonic Temple is on the left-hand side just past
N. 80th Street

From SR 99 Northbound

Turn left at N. 85th Street
Turn left on Greenwood Avenue North
Greenwood Masonic Temple is on the left-hand side just past
N. 80th Street

From SR 99 Southbound

Turn right at N. 85th Street
Turn left on Greenwood Avenue North
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N. 80th Street

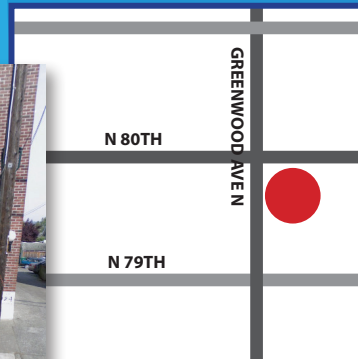
